PLAN OF THE BAY OF CADIZ



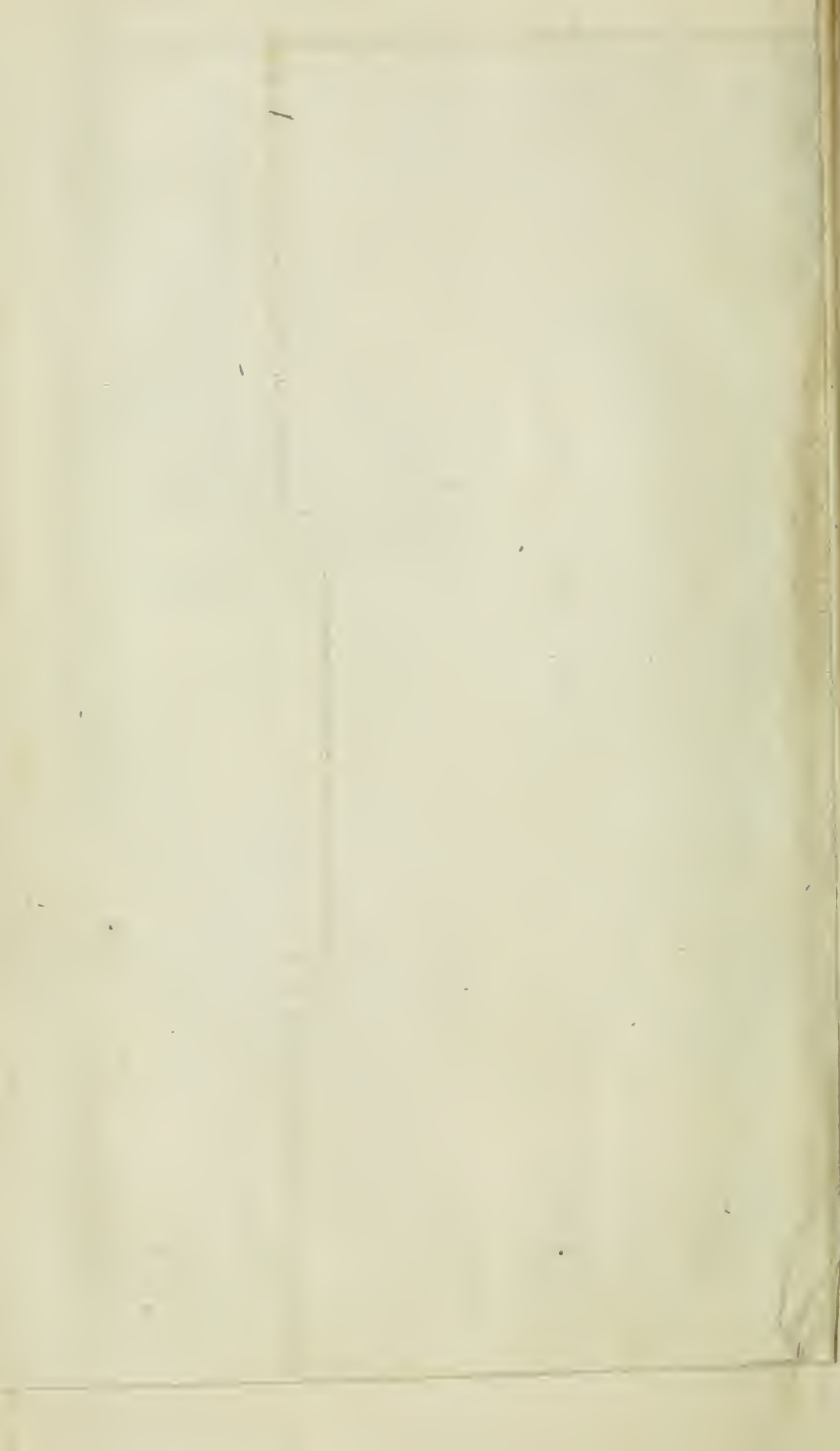


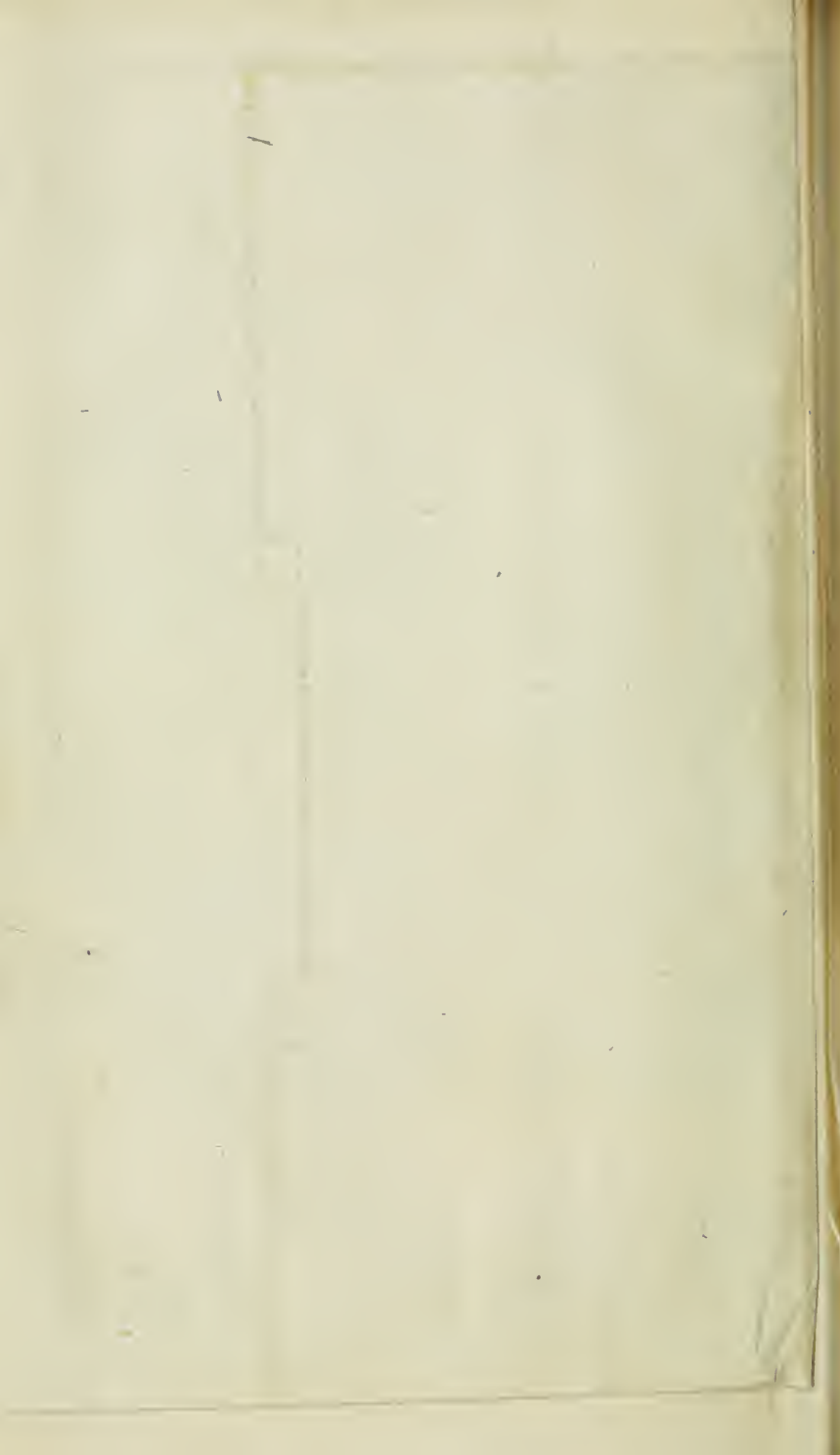

PLAN of the Attack of the Floating-Batteries

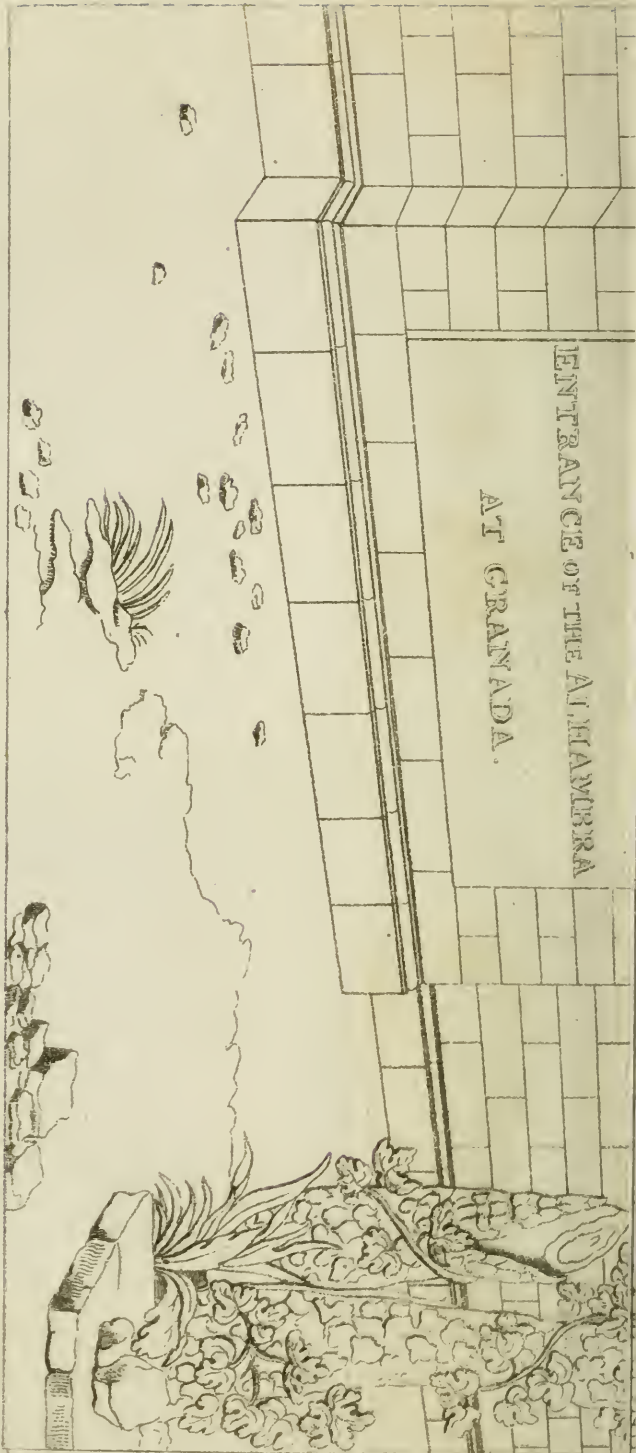

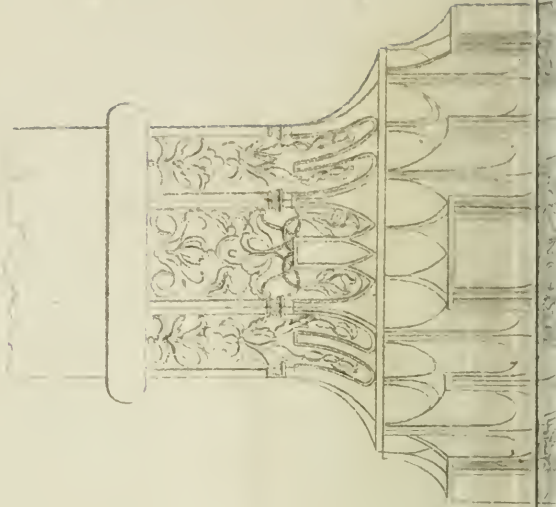
PLAN & ELEVATION OF THE FOUNTAIN IN THE LIONS' COURT
IN THE CASTLE OF ALHAMBRA



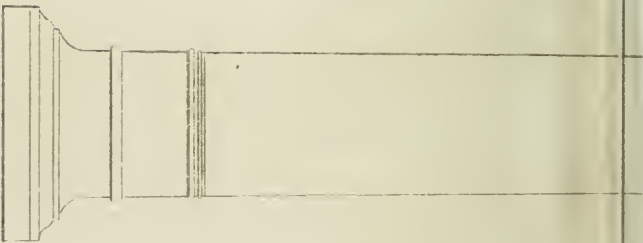
