UNITED STATES POSTAL SLOGAN CANCELS

The rapidly increasing number of philatelists who are turning to the collection of slogan cancels, together with a tremendous increase in the use of slogan cancels during recent years, have combined to bring about an urgent need for a complete catalog of all such material.

With the help of such prominent collectors as Col. Max G. Johl, F.L. Ellis, Walter Marple, Benjamin J. Senuta, Jr., Carl E. Lewis, U.S. Twentieth Century Postal Cancellation Society, New York Chapter, and many others who have taken the trouble to send slogans, tracings, and information, such a catalog has been attempted.

The catalog is in alphabetical order according to the first word of the slogan. No numbering system has been employed for the obvious reason that since new slogans are appearing every day, the addition of each new slogan would call for renumbering. Pricing has not been undertaken due to the facts that (1) there is no definite source of supply, and (2) any values given would be out of date on the day of issue of the catalog.

The main list consists of all slogans used in continental United States, Hawaii and Puerto Rice. Those slogans used in the Philippines and Canal Zone, also Non - Slogan Machine Markings similar in appearance to slogans, are listed separately.

The first column gives the exact wording of the slogan, disregarding the division of the words into lines, due to the fact that the lines sometimes differ on the various machines.

The second column gives the town or city where the slogan was in use; where the same slogan was used in several cities, the various cities are not list ed unless such information is vital.

The third column gives the year or years in which the slogan was used. One day use is noted when known.

The fourth column describes the kind of cancelling device, whether hand or machine, and in the case of the latter the commercial name of the machine is given. The Illustrated Identity Chart will aid the collector in identifying the various machines.

The slogans listed are only those used by the Post Office Department with the devices for the cancelling of stamps, and not the slogans used with the Pitney Bowes or Commercial Controls meter machines.

Grateful acknowledgement is given to previous publications, especially to TUCKER'S U.S. SLOGAN POSTMARK CATALOG, and to XX KILLERS, official organ of the U.S. TWENTIETH CENTURY POSTAL CANCELLATION SOCIETY, for the use of material and/or illustrations; also to numerous collectors, known and unknown in addition to those mentioned in paragraph 2, who have contributed actual slogans and/or drawings. Additional information and/or corrections will be greatly appreciated by the author and will be used, with due credit, in future supplements.

It is suggested that collectors who desire to keep up to date on current slogans should join the U.S. Twentieth Century Postal Cancellation Society, concerning which full information will be found elsewhere.

S 1 O G A N C A N C E L S

Slogan cancels are used in the "KILLER part of the cancelling device by the Post Office Department inorder to deface and cancel the postage stamp. Meter Slogans affixed by means of the Pitney Bowes or Commercial Controls meter machines are not classified as Slogan Cancels.

HOW TO COLLECT


- A- Entire Cover 6 3/4 envelope (3 5/8" x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ")
 - 1- Mount in standard cover or photo albums
 - 2- File alphabetically by slogan or city in shoe boxes, 6 3/4 envelope boxes or drawer files.
- B- Government Postcards, 3\frac{1}{4}x5\frac{1}{2} cards, 3x5 cards
 - 1- Mount or file same as covers. Slogans appear best when using 2 ½cent Presidentials on cards.
- C- 2x4's -Strip cut from the envelopes or cards 2" x 4" including the dater circle, slogan cancel and stamp.
 - 1- Hinge mount on album pages in any way or position that suits you.
 - 2- File in match book boxes or any other suitable item.
- D- Socked On The Nose -Slogan appearing on the stamp and stamp removed from envelope or card.
 - 1- Hinge mount on standard stamp album pages allowing a page for each slogan and endeavour to obtain the slogan on as many different stamps as possible.
 - 2- Hinge mount by stamp and endeavour to obtain the same stamp with as many slogans as possible.


When sending to Postmasters for Slogan Cancels it is advisable to make use of stamps with light colors, such as, GOLD STAR, ANNAPOLIS, $\frac{1}{2}\phi$ and 6ϕ Pres. on the envelopes or cards which are to bear the cancel. Dark colored stamps will conceal the cancel unless the stamps are placed in a position to receive the strike of the dater circle.

From such files, by exchanging information between the different groups in different parts of the country, we expect to build up enough information to form a fairly complete history of 20th Century cancellations; these files can be started at once by individual members and later pooled and classified.

To promote Philately generally and provide a means for future collectors to learn the story of these cancellations while such information is still available.

The dues are \$ 1.00 per year and this includes a one year subscription to XX KILLERS, the official publication of the Society.





WHY AN AQUARIUM?

There are many good reasons for an aquarium in every home. While in the past the keeping of goldfish was associated with the arduous nuisance of changing the water, mess and fuss and bother - modern science has shown us how to eliminate this objectionable feature entirely.

If the tank has plenty of plants, the right amount of light to make the plants grow, and you don't over feed the fish - a modern aquarium can go years without ever changing the water yet it will be pure and clear - with odd bright colored fish and lush plants.

Modern aquariums are decorative. They suit the small home as a means of having living thriving plants to soften the harshness of furniture and the walls. These water plants are not only the cheapest of house plants but are the hardiest - having no pests and growing with a minimum of care. The aquarium with its essential light serves as a lamp to brighten a dark corner or add interest to a problem nook.

As pets for the family, the aquarium fishes are the cheapest and the least trouble of all. No fish must be aired. No fish barks or howls. And only fish can be left for as long as a week without feeding or other attention without damage.

As a hobby the aquarium is unequaled - the lore is easily aquired and one (continued)

soon finds that one is an expert and is exploring new territory as the science of Ichthyology is virgin compared to most sciences. There are endless processes to test and many discoveries have been made by amateurs with little previous experience.

An aquarium can be self supporting. The excess fish and plants can be traded or sold for additional supplies from most fish dealers.

For the frustrated gardener - the aquarium in the living room can be a substitute for the five acres and independence. There is the fun of working on the design of the planting and the same articlic pleasure in a well planted tank that the flower arranger or gardener finds with so much greater labor and expense.

There are many other values in keeping an aquarium in a room. For example the water evaporating slowly from the aquarium humidifies the air and is often recommended by physicians for this purpose as well as for the important therapeutic effects of this quiet relaxing hobby. Many persons with exacting high tensioned jobs find that they can gaze at their fish swimming slowly about the tank with the same surease that is found in a fire place. The cares of the day slide into the background as one watches the antics of the fish.

Children are fascinated by the fish as much as adults. They quickly learn the names and habits and are most reliable in the chores of feeding. And through the odd reproductive habits of the fish parents find an excellent channel for sex education that informs and illustrates simply and clearly.

Cost is low in the purchase of an aquarium. Any budget that can affort a cat or dog will find that fish are less than half the cost of a pure breed puppy and the annual maintainance is less than the cost of one day's food for Fido.
